- Answer key (make sure the math is correct)
- Clear concise **directions** on how the activity should be implemented
- Make sure your activity can be implemented in 10 minutes or less. Assume that students know the material. The activity is just meant to practice or enforce a topic that I would have hypothetically taught the same day
